Prof Brian M. Frier (UK)

(Hons), MD, FRCP(Edin), FRCP(Glas), is Honorary Professor of Diabetes at the University of Edinburgh, affiliated to the British Heart Foundation Centre for Cardiovascular Science. Formerly, he worked as a clinician in the National Health Service and was a Consultant Physician in general (internal) medicine and diabetes at the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh (1987-2012) and at the Western Infirmary and Gartnavel General Hospital, Glasgow (1982-87). He graduated in medicine from the University of Edinburgh and was a Clinical Research Fellow at Cornell University Medical Center in New York, USA. Professor Frier's principal research interest is the pathophysiology of hypoglycemia in humans with relevance to diabetes. He has published extensively and has co-edited two multi-author international textbooks on hypoglycemia and diabetes. His other research interests in diabetes include driving, and cognitive function. An invited speaker on hypoglycemia at many national and international meetings, he gave the Banting Memorial lecture at Diabetes UK in 2009 and the Camillo Golgi lecture at the 53rd annual EASD conference in 2017. In 2004 he received the Somogyi Award from the Hungarian Diabetes Association for his research on hypoglycemia. Prof Frier was Vice-President of the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh (2008-12), and Chair of the Medical Advisory Panel on Driving and Diabetes to the Secretary of State for Transport in the UK from 2001-2012.



Prof Dario Rahelic (Croatia)

Dario Rahelic is assistant professor and Head of Department of Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolic Disorders at Dubrava University Hospital, Zagreb, Croatia, and is President of the Croatian Society for Diabetes and Metabolic Disorders of the Croatian Medical Association. He also serves as Executive Committee member of the Diabetes and Nutrition Study Group of EASD, the Croatian Endocrine Society, the Croatian Society for Obesity and the Croatian Society for Endocrine Oncology.

Prof Nebojša M. Lalić (Bosnia)

(1958), MD, PhD, FRCP, is currently Professor of Internal Medicine at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Belgrade as well as Director and Head of the Department for Metabolic Disorders, Intensive Treatment and Cell Therapy in Diabetes, Clinic for Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolic Diseases, Clinical Centre of Serbia in Belgrade.

Professor Lalic graduated in 1982 at Faculty of Medicine in Belgrade where he completed residency in Internal medicine in 1990, as well as his PhD thesis in 1993. In 1991, he was a visiting scientist at the Clinical Research Section and Immunology Section, Joslin Diabetes Center, Boston, USA. The principal interest of Professor Lalic scientific work in diabetology/endocrinology has been concentrated on the relationship between insulin secretion and insulin sensitivity impairments in Type 2 diabetes, their relevance for the pathogenesis of diabetes and its late complications and the possibilities of their therapeutic modulation (especially insulin pump treatment). In this context, he is also intensively involved in the metabolic studies of the possibilities of early detection and prevention of Type 2 diabetes, as well as of the late diabetic complications and comorbidities, especially coronary heart disease, ischemic stroke and neurodegenerative disorders. Professor Lalic has been involved in more than 200 papers in extenso in international journals, chapters, monographies and textbooks. He has been an investigator in several national and international projects, reviewer at many international meetings or journals.

Professor Lalic has been Chair of the national expert committee for diabetes from 2002. Moreover, he is member in several national and international medical associations and societies. Until now he chaired organizing committee of three EASD Postgraduate Courses in Belgrade. Also, he is at present member of the Board of the IDF Europe.

From 2012 he is the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine University of Belgrade. In addition, he has been elected for corresponding member in 2006 and for the full member of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts in 2012.



Prof Rayaz A. Malik, (UK)

He graduated in Medicine from the University of Aberdeen in 1991, obtained his MRCP in 1996, PhD from the University of Manchester in 1997 and was elected to become a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians in 2007. He was appointed as Consultant Physician and Senior Lecturer in 2001 and as Professor of Medicine and Consultant Physician in 2008 in Central Manchester University Teaching Hospitals and the University of Manchester. He was appointed as Professor of Medicine at Weill Cornell Medicine in 2014 and is an honorary Professor of Medicine and Consultant Physician at Central Manchester University Teaching Hospitals and University of Manchester and visiting Professor of Medicine at Manchester Metropolitan University. He was appointed as the Organizational Official for Weill Cornell Medicine in Qatar in November 2016. Over the last 15 years he has pioneered the use of corneal confocal microscopy, a non-invasive ophthalmic instrument, to quantify diabetic and other peripheral neuropathies. More recently he has applied CCM to establish it as a surrogate for neuronal damage in patients with Stroke, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's disease and Dementia. He was the President of Neurodiab (the diabetic neuropathy study group of the EASD) from 2009-2012. He is an associate editor for Diabetic Medicine (2006 to present); J of Diabetes and its Complications (2012-present), PLOS One (2016- present), BMC Neurology (2009-present) and Advances in Therapy (2009- present). He is on the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation Complications and Clinical Investigation Research Committee (2005-present).

Dr. V. Mohan is the Chairman and Chief of Diabetology at Dr. Mohan's Diabetes Specialities Centre at Chennai in South India which is an IDF Centre of Excellence in Diabetes Care. Dr. Mohan oversees a chain of 48 diabetes centres across 8 states of India and has over 500,000 registered diabetes patients in his centres,. He is also President and Director of the Madras Diabetes Research Foundation which is Asia's largest stand alone diabetes research centre.

Deeply interested in research from his undergraduate medical student days, Dr. Mohan has published over 1300 papers in peer reviewed journals. This includes 852 original articles, 292 review articles and invited editorials and 162 chapters to text-books on Diabetes. His research has attracted 129,000 citations a 'h index' of 131. Dr. Mohan has trained a large number of physicians & diabetologists in addition to Nurses, Educators and received over 180 awards including the prestigious Dr. B.C. Roy National Award by the Medical Council of India and the Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Centenary Award from the Indian Council of Medical Research, the highest award for Biomedical research in India.
