
Health Organization for diabetes and NCD's. His research and clinical work focus on diabetes care, and he serves as President of the Portuguese Diabetes Society.

Exploring obesity-related endocrine disorders beyond diabetes: a narrative review

Background:

While insulin resistance and diabetes shine as the central stars in the constellation of obesityrelated conditions, other common endocrine diseases are also closely associated with obesity and high body mass index

Main body:

This review aims to illuminate the hormonal imbalances associated with obesity, beyond diabetes. It covers the prevalence, clinical presentation, screening, diagnosis, and treatment of some of these conditions. Hypothyroidism is the commonest endocrinal disorder associated with obesity after T2 diabetes, the relationship between both conditions are reciprocal. While hypothyroidism is a predisposing factor to obesity. Obesity is associated with mildly elevated TSH and less consistent changes in T4 and T3 levels. There fore in obese people with mild elevation of TSH exclusion of autoimmune hypothyroidism is required before attributing these changes to obesity. In all obese people screening for hypothyroidism is recommended. Upper body obesity is a feature in Cushing's syndrome (CS). Given the high prevalence of obesity and the low incidence of CS, screening of all obese individuals for endogenous hypercortisolism results in high false positive rates. Therefore, only obese patients exhibiting more specific signs of the CS like skin thinning, wide purple striae, spontaneous ecchymosis, proximal myopathy, and osteoporosis should undergo CS screening. In candidates for bariatric surgery ruling out CS is recommended if exhibiting suspicious clinical signs. Apart of polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) which is prevalent in approximately one-third of obese females, obesity can lead to obesity-related hyperandrogenemia, particularly during adolescence due to hyperinsulinemia and insulin resistance coupled with insulin effects on steroidogenic cells which retain insulin sensitivity. Other rare condition of hyperandrogenism in females is congenital adrenal hyperplasia. Women with obesity should be screened if there are features of hyperandrogenism. menstrual abonormalities and infertility. There is an association between obesity in men and hypogonadism. Functional secondary hypogonadism and impaired sperm concentration, motility, and morphology were found in obese. The relationship between male obesity and hypogonadism is rather a complex and bidirectional. Screening of obese men for functional hypogonadism is indicated only if there are suggestive features of hypogonadism and after excluding of other causes. Although hormonal levels show some differences between obese and nonobese there is no evidence based different screening methods or management protocols in obese.

Conclusion:

In obese patients, physicians must pay attention to hormonal disorders that may be associated with obesity.

Risk Stratification in People with Diabetes for Fasting During Ramadan: Consensus from Arabic Association for the Study of Diabetes and Metabolism

Background:

Current international guidelines recommend a pre-Ramadan risk assessment for people with diabetes (Pw DM) who plan on fasting during the Holy month. However, a comprehensive risk assessment-based recommendation for the management of Pw DM intending to fast is still controversial. Therefore, the Arabic Association for the Study of Diabetes and Metabolism (AASD) developed this consensus to provide further insights into risk stratification in Pw DM with/without diabetes related comorbidities who are intending to fast during Ramadan. Methods: The present consensus was based on the three-step modified Delphi method. The Delphi method is based on a series of voting rounds and in-between meetings of the high, moderate, and low risk).

This statement aims to explore the most suitable diet for Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region and provide guidance for physicians to overcome barriers in optimal care. While most dietary guidelines focus on uncomplicated diabetes, it's essential to recognize that diabetes often coexists with other common diseases in our region. Conclusion International guidelines cannot be directly applied to the Egypt and Arab countries due to cultural and dietary differences. Our position statement shares valuable insights into managing diabetes in special situations and diverse clinical settings within this region. These recommendations are flexible, considering personal, cultural, and traditional differences
